

# LAKESIDE LOVE From Merrily Rocco, owner

WHERE AND WHEN: The weeding of Abby and Nic took place in July 2011 at a private lakefront estate on the west shore of Lake Tahoe.

WEDDING PERSONALITY: This was a quintessentially Tahoe wedding, and the couple's personalities were incorporated in imaginative ways.

DÉCOR DETAILS: Pops of fuchsia accented a color palette of navy, orange, white, champagne and spring green, with vibrant orange touches. Nic and his groomsmen's seersucker suits inspired such details as the navy pinstriped napkins.

Since Abby is a teacher, chalkboards served as the table numbers. Her collection of wine corks inspired the table number and bar menu frames. The bar displayed vases filled with corks, white dendrobiums and limes.

Mason jars were used to serve the signature drink—the Tahoe Tessie, named after a mythical lake monster—as well as to showcase family photos. To enhance the lakeside look, escort cards—stamped with beach cruisers, which the couple loves to ride—were presented on old shutters found by the bride.

The dining area's rustic Tahoe feel included burlap runners on the tables over a Tuscarry eggshell knobby linen, and walnut wood dining chairs and chargers. The centerpieces were a mix of clear pedestal vases and ceramic white pitchers with single stems. Pennant flags were strung below the main bar, around tree trunks and around the candy table.

FOOD AND DRINK: Catered by As You Wish, the menu featured a plated mixed entrée dinner of filet mignon and mahimahi. Late-night sliders and mini-grilled cheese sandwiches were served. A twist on traditional red velvet, the orange velvet cake was topped by miniature figures dressed in exact replicas of Abby and Nic's wedding attire. Guests could also pick out treats from the Candy Bar, served on a wooden farm table topped with a burlap runner.

MOST MEMORABLE MOMENT: "An hour before Nic and his groomsmen were to be picked up by a viritage woody boat (quintessentially Tahoe), the captain called me with















bad news—the boat wouldn't start. Using my sources, we had them picked up in a beautiful boat on time, and no one was the wiser. This resulted in one of my favorite moments of the day, which I didn't even witness. While Nic and his groomsmen were waiting for the second boat to arrive, another boat came by and shared a bottle of champagne with them. Turns out the charitable couple were past clients of mine married last September, and they were sharing a bottle from their wedding!"

WHY THIS WEDDING "WOWED": "I really loved this wedding, with the fresh punches of orange used in unexpected places, as well as the multitude of motifs—wine corks, pennant flags, pinstripes and rustic Tahoe touches. The details came together perfectly, imparting a fresh feel and reflecting the personalities of Abby and Nic."—Mernly Rocco
